WELL THAT'S IT FOR ANOTHER YEAR, WE'D LIKE TO APOLOGISE FOR THE DELAY IN THE RESULTS, ONE OR TWO DIFFICULTIES AROSE AND THERE YOU ARE, NEARLY A MONTH LATE! THANKS TO ALL FOR WAITING, AND ALSO THANKS FOR SUPPORTING THE EVENT. THIS YEAR IT WAS THE LAST ROUND OF THE FIRST NATIONAL TABLETOP CHAMPIONSHIP, AND I AM GLAD TO SAY THAT IT WAS A CLIFF HANGER RIGHT UP TO THE END AS THE CHAMPIONSHIP WAS TIED AFTER THE LAST ROUND. NEXT YEAR WE ARE PROMOTING THE CHAMPIONSHIP AGAIN, BUT WITH A NEW EVENT AS THE LAST ROUND, THE RALLY ROUND NATIONAL TABLE TOP RALLY. TO GIVE YOU A TASTE OF WHAT'S TO COME, THE EVENT IS RUNNING INDEPENDENTLY THIS YEAR IN MAY, AND A SET OF REGULTIONS ARE ENCLOSED FOR YOU TO PERUSE.

NEXT YEAR'S PEGASUS NATIONAL WILL SEE A CHANGE OF FORMAT FOR THE NOVICES, WHERE WE INTEND TO RUN THE NOVICE SECTION PURELY ON A FUN BASIS, WITH NOVICE ENTRANTS PAYING SUBSTANTIALLY LESS AND JUST RECEIVING A COMPLETE SET OF PAPERWORK/EXPLANATIONS/RESULTS. WE HAVE MADE THIS MOVE BECAUSE MANY NOVICES NEVER SEND THEIR MAPS OR QUESTION SHEETS BACK AND WE DON'T SEE WHY THEY SHOULD SUBSIDISE THE PRIZE FUND OF THE MORE CAPABLE ENTRANTS. WE ARE MAINLY CONCERNED WITH INTRODUCING PEOPLE TO THE PLEASURE( AND PAIN?) OF TABLETOP RALLYING AS AN ADJUNCT TO MOTORSPORTING NAVIGATION. WITH THE RECENT RULE CHANGES IN ROAD RALLYING MANY EVENTS ARE NOW TURNING TO THE PLOT'N'BASH TYPE FORMAT USING MORE DIFFICULT NAVIGATION, AND THE TABLETOP SCENE AS A WHOLE IS VERY GOOD PRACTICE FOR ALL CLASSES OF NAVIGATOR.

TABLETOPPING BEGAN AS AN OFFSHOOT OF RALLY NAVIGATION, AND THUS IS A TEST OF INITIATIVE AS WELL AS PRECISION.

THIS IS OUR VIEWPOINT, AND AS ACTIVE PROPONENTS OF THE SPORT WE READ SOME ASPECTS ACROSS TO TABLETOPS. AS YOU HAVE SEEN, EVEN BRILLIANT ORGANISERS SUCH AS OURSELVES CAN MAKE ELEMENTARY MISTAKES, AND WE DO EXPECT YOU TO USE YOUR HEAD IF YOU PLOT HALF WAY THROUGH A SECTION AND THEN COME TO A DEAD STOP. WE WILL NEVER PENALISE STRICTLY IF A COMPETITOR HAS 'JUMPED THE GAP' AND GOT OVER THE ERROR AND FINISHED THE SECTION. IF THE SAME PROBLEM CAME UP ON THE ROAD, WOULD YOU TURN AROUND AND GO HOME, OR GO IN EVER INCREASING CIRCLES UNTIL YOU MADE SOME CONTACT WITH THE ROUTE? I'LL LEAVE YOU TO ANSWER THAT ONE.

A WORD TO OUR 'UNATTACHED' MEMBERS... IF THE LAST TWO PARAGRAPHS ARE GOBBLEDEGOOK TO YOU, DON'T THINK THAT WE DON'T CATER FOR THE NON-MOTORSPORTER, BECAUSE WE OBVIOUSLY HAVE YOUR ATTENTION! WE WELCOME ALL INTERESTED PARTIES TO THE GENRE, WETHER IT BE BY WORD OF MOUTH OR SIDELINE CONNECTION WITH A MOTOR CLUB, IT'S JUST THAT IT SEEMS SOMEWHAT DAFT TO PUT 'UNATTACHED' ALONSIDE COMPETITORS' NAMES: - IF ANYONE CAN COME UP WITH A BETTER ALTERNATIVE, PLEASE LET US KNOW!
